Ready, Set, Start Shipping! Several Teams have started shipping their cars to St. George. Here's how it works. Ship your car to;

You can also set up return shipping during this time so you don't have to fill out all the paperwork after the race.

Your car will be held at the BGI station holding yard (at the address above). BGI will transport your car, in its crate, to the practice (at the Dixie Center), Friday morning. You can arrange to pick up your car prior to Friday, at the holding yard, by calling ahead. BGI will have a trailer at the race track on Saturday for return shipping. You must drain the gasoline and oil.

For those that have shipped your car for storage at St. George mini storage, you can e-mail me to access your car. We will deliver your car to the practice event with your tote and pick your car and tote up at the end of race day for storage. No draining required.



Yes, there are still open slots for you to store your car in St. George. It's cheaper to store cars here than to ship back.

Early car inspections. The Tech Team will be available Thursday to inspect a limited amount of cars. Let me know if you are interested. The new cars will require additional time to safety check on Friday. Especially the live axle section.
